BRIDGEWATER TOWNSHIP NOTICE

PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40:49-2(a), NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Township Council of the Township of Bridgewater, County of Somerset, introduced and passed on first reading at its meeting on **March 19, 2026**, the following ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRIDGEWATER AMENDING CHAPTER 182 OF THE BRIDGEWATER TOWNSHIP CODE TO REQUIRE SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL FROM PRIVATE ROADWAYS SERVICING MULTIFAMILY RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENTS

The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish and clarify the responsibility of property owners to remove snow and ice from all public sidewalks abutting their land, as well as from private roadways and sidewalks servicing multifamily residential developments of three or more units. All such areas must be cleared within twelve (12) daylight hours after snowfall ceases or ice has formed to ensure safe pedestrian and vehicular passage and to maintain essential access for emergency services.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that said ordinance will be further considered for final passage on **April 9, 2026**, at 7:00 p.m. or soon thereafter at a meeting of the Township Council to be held at 100 Commons Way, Bridgewater, NJ 08807. All persons interested shall be given an opportunity at that time to be heard concerning said ordinance.

Any member of the general public may obtain, without cost, a copy of the entire ordinance from the Municipal Clerk at the Bridgewater Township Municipal Building, 100 Commons Way, during normal business hours (9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday) at any time up to and including the time when the Township Council shall further consider this ordinance for final passage.
