- e) AUTHORIZING AN ADDITIONAL \$75,000.00 TO RJM LANDSCAPE AND DESIGN, LLC OF 821 PARSONAGE HILL DRIVE, BRANCHBURG, NJ 08876 FOR SNOW REMOVAL SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$150,000.00 FOR THE 2024 - 2025 WINTER SEASON TO BE FUNDED FROM TEMPORARY MUNICIPAL BUDGET CURRENT FUND ACCOUNT
